PAST EVENTS

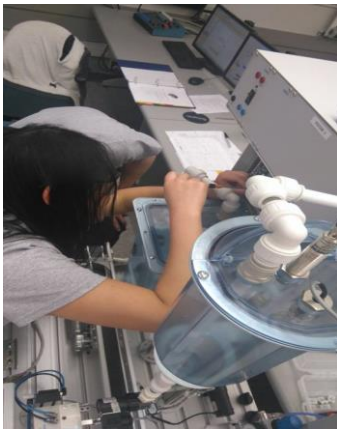
2 & 4 wire seminar
